RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES

1. Registration fee for the event Movie Making is Rs 200 per team.
2. Registration fee for the events Coding and Web designing each is Rs 100 per Individual.
3. For all other events the registration fee is Rs 50 per student.
4. Outstation candidates must inform 2 weeks prior commencement of events for accommodation facilities.
5. All the participants should reach the college at 8.30 am on the day of their event.
6. The schedule of events will be published in our website one week prior to the fest.
7. All participants must carry their college ID card / Letter from Head of the Institution along with them.
8. Slots will be cancelled after three calls. No re-entry allowed under any circumstances.
9. If any kind of malpractice is found in any event, that team / participant will be disqualified.
10. Those interested to participate should register online through our website on or before 25/01/2014. The registration fee to be paid at the payment counter on the days of the fest.
11. The judges decisions will be final for all events.

RULES FOR ALL EVENTS

1. Counter Strike (GAMING)

1. Only a team of 5 members is allowed.
2. Maximum of Two teams per college.
3. Participants are allowed to bring hardware components (only Keyboard and Mouse) along with them.

2. Tesouro Caza (TREASURE HUNT)

1. Only a team of four members is allowed.
2. One team per college.

3. Filme Machen (MOVIE MAKING)

1. Team size of 2 members.
2. Time limit: should not exceed 10 minutes.
3. Entries shall be based on specified theme related to environment in detail.
4. Participants should send their script one week prior to the date of the event (on or before 29th January, 2015).
5. Selected teams should bring their work (Short movie or documentary) in a CD or pen drive.
6. Judgment will be strictly based on title of the movie, script, how the theme is expressed, acting, editing and technical effects.

4.Loistava Kodigo (CODING)

1. Competition is limited to final year MCA students even with a maximum of one standing arrears to take part in the contest. However, they should have cleared all papers and should have secured a minimum aggregate score of 65% throughout their academics to be eligible to join UST Global if they are being offered a job.
2. Eligibility requirements is a minimum of 65% marks in 10th, 12th and degree examinations (all from recognized boards/universities).
3. Individual participants.
4. Decisions of the judges will be final.

ROUND 1 (PRELIMS)

1. This round includes:
 - a. Aptitude test based on C/C++ programming language (30 Questions)
 - b. Quantitative aptitude test (10 Questions)
 - c. Logical reasoning (10 Questions)
 - d. Basic English (10 Questions)
2. Time limit – 45 minutes (for 60 questions).
3. There will be no negative marks.

ROUND 2 (SEMI-FINALS)

1. This round includes two programming questions in C/C++ and Java respectively.
2. Time limit – 1 ½ hours.

ROUND 3 (FINALS)

Interview by UST Global panel.

5.Splentna Modelea (WEB DESIGNING)

1. Maximum 2 members per team (Individual participation is also allowed).
2. Theme will be given on the spot.
3. Tools and requirements will be provided.
4. Facilities provided: Dreamweaver, Photoshop, Illustrator, Basic HTML
5. Mobile phones and usage of internet are not allowed

ROUND 1 (PRELIMS)

1. Logo Designing
2. Time limit – 30 Minutes

ROUND 2 (FINALS)

1. Web page designing
2. Time limit – 1 Hour

6. Twinkle Toes (GROUP DANCE)

1. Teams should consist of maximum 8 participants.
2. All dance styles are allowed.
3. There should be separate teams for boys and girls (Mixed performances are not allowed).
4. Props can be used by the participating teams by their own choice. No extra marks will be provided for the same.
5. Teams won't be provided for the props (if any) by the organizers. (No hazardous objects allowed)
6. Only college teams are allowed (No professional groups allowed)
7. Participants should submit music, 30mins before the event starts
8. Time limit: 6+2mins
9. The participating team will be responsible for the removal of the sets, properties etc immediately after the completion of the performance
10. Judgment will be based on the rhythm, formation, expression, costumes, make up, coordination and overall effects
11. Only the first 10 teams registering will be allowed to compete in the first come first serve order.

7. Theatre De Rue (STREET PLAY)

1. Team size : 5 to 10 participants per team
2. To be performed in open air, so settings to be circular
3. Duration of performance shall be a maximum of 10 minutes.
4. Play should be based on the given theme " Waste Management"
5. Medium of presentation can be English / Malayalam.
6. Accompanying Instruments, props to be arranged by the team itself.
7. Copy of the script should be submitted 1 week prior to the competition (on or before 29th January, 2015).
8. Essentials: Narrator (Kathikan),chorus,songs,costumes and focus on theme.
9. Only the selected team will be permitted to compete.

8. eHulladek Formas d'art(E-WASTE ART FORM)

1. Individual Event.
2. Participant should bring a model prepared in advance, made up entirely of e-waste on the day of the event
3. Points awarded for aesthetics and use of the object

9. Pasta Creazione (POSTER MAKING)

1. Individual competition.
2. Participants shall bring their own art materials.
3. Theme will be given on the spot.
4. Chart paper will be provided.
